In search of the origins of our Entwistle family

This research report outlines the outcomes from my research into the antecedents of my 5G-grandmother Betty Entwistle (1764-1831). I managed to trace her Entwistle ancestors back another three generations.

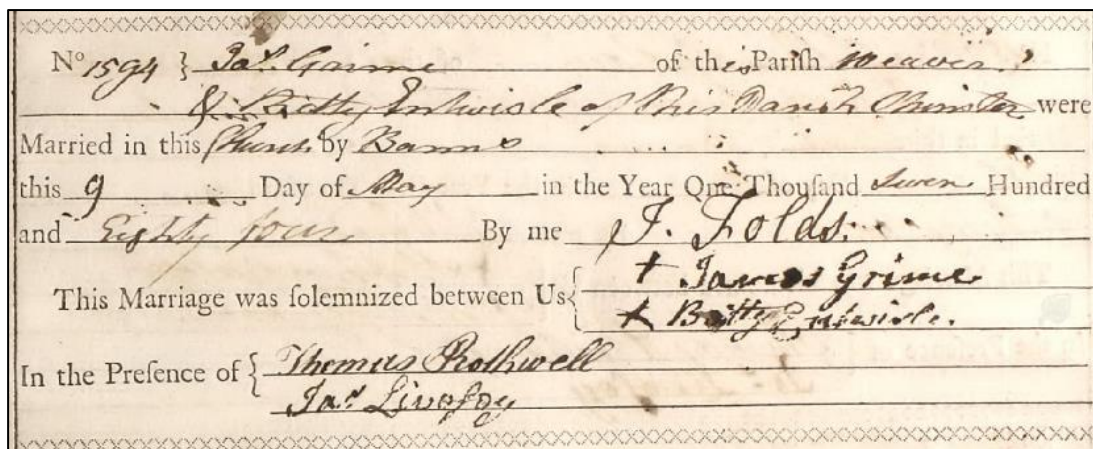

## What we know

My 5G-grandparents Betty Entwistle and James Grime were married at St Peter's Church in Bolton (Lancashire) on 9 May 1784<sup>1</sup>. I outlined in my earlier research report on the Grime family origins (*Layers of Grime*) how I identified this record as relating to my family<sup>2</sup>.

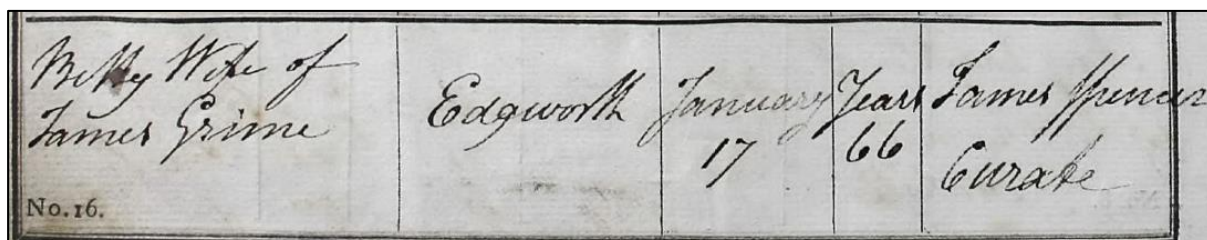


**Illustration 1: Marriage record for James Grime and Betty Entwistle, St Peter's Church (Bolton) 9 May 1784**

James and Betty had six children<sup>3</sup>, as follows:

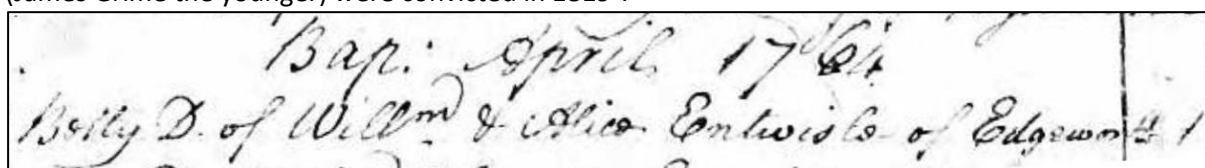
- John baptised 5 Dec 1784 at Haslingden (abode Bolton Parish);
- William baptised 18 Aug 1786 at Haslingden (abode Edgworth);
- Alice baptised 17 Aug 1788 at Haslingden;
- Jane buried 5 June 1789 aged 2 weeks at Blackburn (abode Bent Gapp);
- Mally baptised 18 Apr 1790 at Haslingden (abode Edgworth); and
- James baptised 9 Oct 1796 at Haslingden (abode Bolton Parish) – my 4G-grandfather.

Betty Grime died in January 1831 and was buried at St Ann's Church, Turton<sup>4</sup>. The burial register records her age as 66 years, implying a birth year of 1765. Her husband James was buried in the same church 8 months later.

Based on my earlier research report<sup>2</sup>, I concluded that Betty was the daughter of William and Alice Entwistle of Edgworth and had been baptised on 1 April 1764 at St Peter's Church, Bolton le Moors<sup>5</sup>; the same church where she was married 20 years later. Her brother Henry (baptised on 16 March 1766<sup>6</sup>) was involved in the same crime for which Betty's husband (James Grime the elder) and son (James Grime the younger) were convicted in 1819<sup>7</sup>.

So, based on that knowledge, I started to search for records that could reveal more about Betty's parents and earlier ancestors.

## Betty's parents

I had established that the parents of Betty and Henry Entwistle were William and Alice Entwistle. I firstly wanted to find the marriage record for William and Alice, but I did not know when they were married. So, I decided to search for baptism records for all their children (in order to narrow down the likely date of the marriage). I started with the extensive baptism indexes provided by the *Lancashire Online Parish Clerks*<sup>8</sup>. These invaluable indexes enabled much of the subsequent research on this family that is described below.

### **Betty Entwistle's siblings**

A search for baptism records between 1762 and 1786 where the parents are William Entwistle and Alice finds 41 matches. These 41 baptisms belong to several large and small families from across Lancashire. For example, I was able to identify the following families:

1. Edgworth 1762 to 1788 = 12 children;
2. Darwen (Lower Chapel) 1765 to 1770 = 4 children;
3. Chorley (St Laurence) 1767 to 1779 = 6 children;
4. Outwood (St Saviour, Ringley) 1773 to 1782 = 5 children;
5. Halliwell and Little Bolton (St Peter's, Bolton) 1773 to 1792 = 7 children.

Those five families account for 33 of the 41 baptisms included in the index for this period. Betty and her brother Henry are two of the twelve children that belong to family number 1 of Edgworth. This is consistent with what we already knew about Betty and her husband James Grime the Elder – that they lived much of their life together at Edgworth; that they were living there when at least 3 of their 6 children were born; and that both were living there when they died in 1831.

I had established in my earlier research report<sup>2</sup> that Betty's husband (James Grime the Elder) had originated in Musdenhead near Haslingden (about 9 miles from Edgworth). This implied that (since James came from elsewhere) Edgworth may have been Betty's hometown. Now, the results of this research of the baptism indexes had provided evidence to corroborate that hypothesis.

The twelve children of Betty's parents (William and Alice) were<sup>8</sup>:

1. Sarah - 26 Sep 1762
2. Betty - 1 Apr 1764
3. Henry – 16 Mar 1766
4. Joseph – 3 Jan 1768
5. Alice – 3 Nov 1771
6. James – 30 Oct 1773
7. Mary – 2 Oct 1775
8. Jane – 10 Aug 1777
9. Edmund – 1 Aug 1779
10. William – 1 Jul 1781
11. Ann – 12 Mar 1786
12. John - 1 Mar 1788

### **Marriage of William Entwistle and Alice Haslam 1762**

I searched *Lancashire Online Parish Clerks* around 1762 (when their eldest child was born) for records of a William Entwistle marrying an Alice near Edgworth. Between 1757 and 1764 there is only one matching record.

There are two later marriages that I discounted. The first is a marriage to Alice Ellisson in April 1765 at Blackburn (with banns read in the previous month). I am fairly sure that this is couple number 2 from the list above (with four children baptised between 1765 and 1770 at Darwen).

The second discounted one is a marriage to Alice Allanson in May 1766 at Blackburn, but the banns are included in a separate 1766 record where her maiden name is spelled Ellisson. So, this seems to be the same couple as mentioned in the previous paragraph.

Having thus eliminated the 1765/66 marriage(s) to Alice Ellisson (or Allanson), I concluded that the only remaining record must relate to Betty's parents. William Entwisle (weaver) married Alice Haslam (spinster) by banns at St Peter's Church Bolton on 15 June 1762<sup>9</sup>. Their eldest daughter (Sarah) was baptised 14 weeks later at St James Church Haslingden.

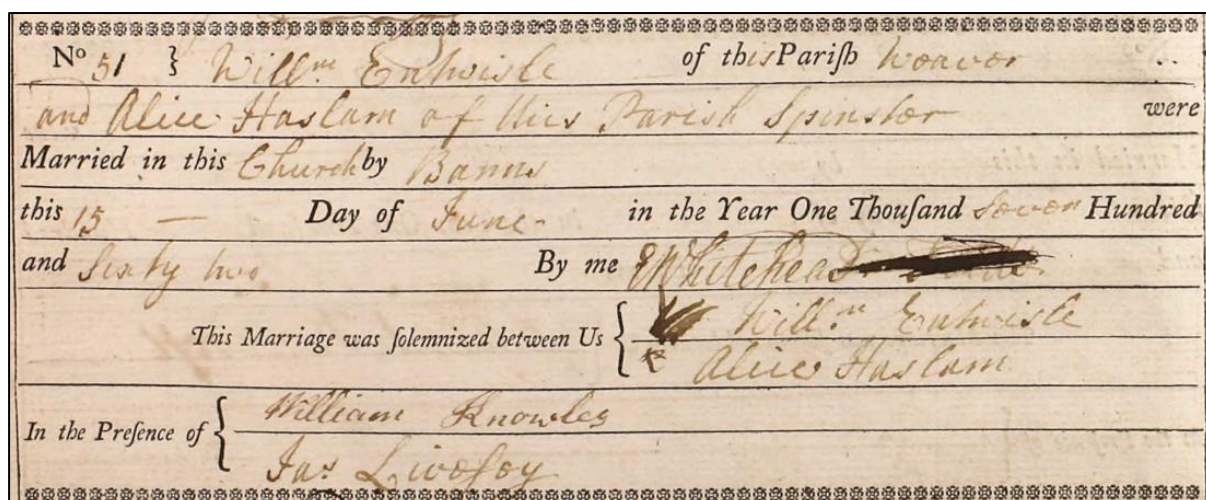


Illustration 4: Marriage record for William Entwisle and Alice Haslam at St Peter's Church Bolton on 15 June 1762

### Burial record for Alice Entwistle 1791

I started my twenty-year search period for William's and Alice's burial records from 1788 (when their youngest son John was baptised). In Alice's case, there were 26 matches (across the whole of Lancashire<sup>8</sup>). Most of these are children and can be easily eliminated.

The burial of Alice Entwisle, wife of William Entwisle, at Chorley on 21 April 1788 is likely to be the wife from couple 3 (who had 6 children baptised there between 1767 and 1779). The burial at St Peter's Bolton on 28 Sep 1790 was for a woman who was 80 years old; too old to have given birth just 2 years earlier.

It is therefore highly likely that our Alice Entwisle (nee Haslam) of Edgworth is the "wife of William Entwisle, weaver" who was buried at St Anne's Church Turton on 7 Feb 1791<sup>10</sup>. This church is 4 miles from Edgworth. She left behind three children under ten years old. Her daughter Alice was buried in the same church ten months later, aged 20<sup>8</sup>.

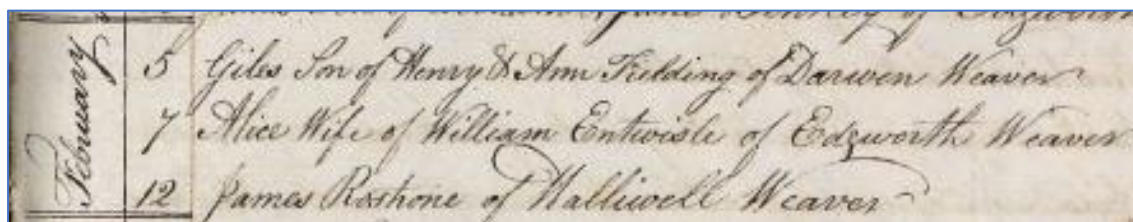


Illustration 5: Burial record for Alice Entwisle nee Haslam at St Anne's Church Turton on 7 February 1791

### Alice Haslam's birth

Alice's children were born between 1762 and 1788, so it is likely that she was born between 1738 and 1748. Nevertheless, I searched *Lancashire Online Parish Clerks* from 1728 to 1748. This found 9 matches, but none of them seem likely. A similar search on Ancestry.com was also fruitless.

### William Entwistle's birth 1743

I searched *Lancashire Online Parish Clerks* from 1727 to 1747 for a baptism record for William Entwistle. There were five matches:

- 1 May 1729 – William (weaver) and Anne of Unsworth (9 miles from Edgworth) = unlikely;
- 8 Feb 1739/40 – Ralph (weaver) & Mary of Bradshaw (4 miles) = possible;
- 14 May 1743 – William (farmer) and Sarah of Edgworth = very possible;
- 6 Apr 1746 – Ralph and Ann of Entwistle (2 miles) = quite possible;
- 5 Nov 1746 – Ralph (weaver) and Susannah of Musdenhead – intriguing.

There is no evidence that the Entwistle family used the naming convention in choosing names for their children. Nevertheless, certain Christian names do recur frequently in subsequent generations (see table). Re-used names include James, John and William (for males) and Alice, Ann and Jane (for girls).

I have not found any members of our Entwistle branch with the name Ralph (even though it is common in other Entwistle branches). Nor is there a Susannah. For that reason, I have discounted baptism number 5 of Musdenhead (even though William's daughter Betty married James Grime who was born at Musdenhead). I discounted baptisms 2 and 4 for the same reason. That narrows it down to 1 and 3.

William and Alice Entwistle named children William, Sarah and Ann; so, baptisms number 1 and 3 are more likely on that basis. But baptism 1 is at the extreme end of the wide time span that I searched; and it

relates to a family that lived at Unsworth, nine miles from Edgworth.

For these reasons, I favour baptism number 3 as the most likely one for our William, but I acknowledge that the body of evidence supporting this hypothesis is not overwhelming (so far). Nevertheless, I subsequently discovered that the names of 1743 Edgworth William's siblings (see below) tended to provide additional weight to this hypothesis, because he used all of them in naming his own children. 1729 Unsworth William seems to have been an only child.

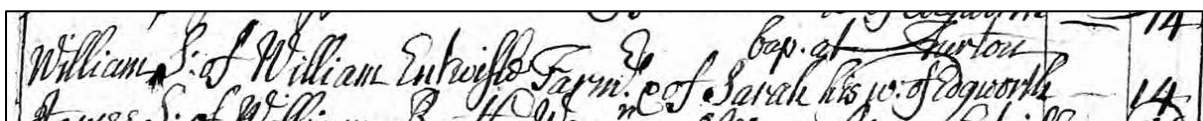


Illustration 6: Baptism record for William Entwistle of Edgworth at St Peter's Church Bolton le Moors on 14 May 1743<sup>11</sup>

### Burial record for William Entwistle 1827

We know from her 1791 burial record that William Entwistle survived his wife Alice. I conducted a similar twenty-year search (1791 to 1811) for his burial record. The indexes of *Lancashire Online Parish Clerks* find 32 matches. Five of these were from Edgworth. Four were described as "son of ..." which normally indicates the burial of a child. The remaining one was buried on 10 December 1795 at St Anne's Church Turton but was described as a Yeoman. Now, our William Entwistle had always previously been recorded as a weaver, so this record is probably not him.

I found his likely burial record among the matches when I searched Ancestry.com for his baptism! It seems quite likely that he is the 84-year-old William Entwistle from Edgworth who was buried at St Anne's Church Turton on 28 March 1827<sup>12</sup>.

## Betty's Entwistle grandparents

If we accept my hypothesis that Betty Entwistle's father William was baptised at Bolton le Moors on 14 May 1743, then his parents were William Entwistle and Sarah. Before searching for their marriage record, I searched for baptism records for their other children.

### Siblings of 1743 William Entwistle

A search of *Lancashire Online Parish Clerks* for children of William Entwistle and Sarah between 1737 and 1757 finds five children who were all baptised at St Peter's Church Bolton le Moors<sup>8</sup>. Their parents lived at Edgworth. There were no others baptised earlier or later. These children were:

1. Alice – 21 Jun 1738
2. William – 14 May 1743
3. Henry – 21 Jul 1745
4. Edmund – 23 Feb 1752
5. Joseph – 10 Apr 1756.

It is notable that William later named one of his children after each of these siblings (see previous page), thus lending support to my hypothesis that he was baptised on 14 May 1743.

### Marriage of William Entwistle and Sarah Knowles 1734/5

A search on *Lancashire Online Parish Clerks* for the marriage of a William Entwistle to a Sarah between 1722 and 1742 finds just one match. So, it is likely that William Entwistle married Sarah Knowles at St Mary the Virgin church at Deane on 20 February 1734/5<sup>13</sup>. Deane is 7 miles from Edgworth. Note that this record is written in Latin, so William is recorded as Gulielmus. His surname is written as Entwistle (where *ſ* is the old form of *s*).

### **Burial of Sarah Entwistle 1791**

I searched on *Lancashire Online Parish Clerks* for the twenty years after the baptism of their last child for a burial record for Sarah Entwistle nee Knowles. It was not there. So, I extended the search for another 20 years. There are 19 matches, but only one matches the known facts about Sarah. Her burial record<sup>14</sup> at St Anne's church Turton on 21 April 1791 gives her abode as Edgworth and her status as widow. Her daughter-in-law (Alice Entwistle nee Haslam) had been buried in the same church just ten weeks earlier (see Illustration 5 above).

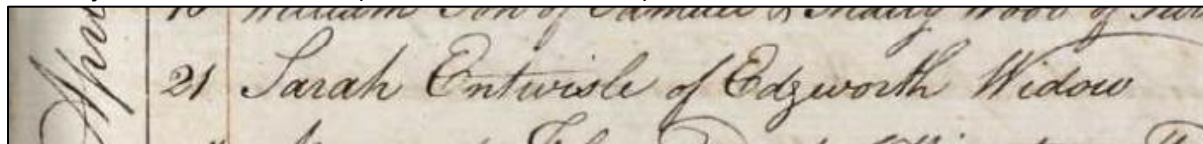


Illustration 9: Burial record for Sarah Entwistle nee Knowles at St Anne's church Turton on 21 April 1791

### **Burial of William Entwistle 1767**

Since his wife Sarah was described on her 1791 burial record as a widow, William Entwistle must have died between 1756 (when his last child was born) and 1791. A search on *Lancashire Online Parish Clerks* yields 44 matches. Restricting that search to just the church of St Anne at Turton (where his wife and daughter-in-law were both buried) reduces the number of matches by half.

If we ignore the records that include the words “son of ...” (which generally indicates the death of a child) we are left with:

1. 20 Apr 1767 of Edgworth
2. 13 Jun 1776 of Turton (Yeoman)
3. 13 Nov 1788 of Tottington (weaver)
4. 30 Dec 1789 of Edgworth (Yeoman)

I would discount records 2 and 4 because our William was a weaver, not a yeoman. I would discount record 3 because he lived at Edgworth, not Tottington (albeit they are only 4 miles apart). So, the most likely burial record for William Entwistle is the 1767 one<sup>15</sup>. If this is the relevant one, his wife outlived him by 24 years.

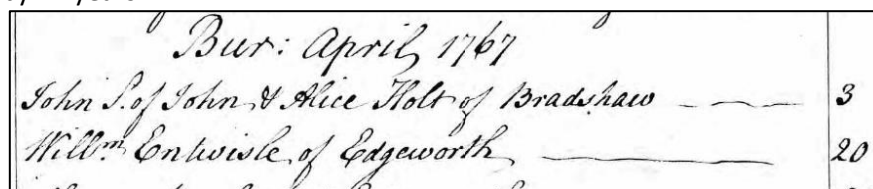


Illustration 10: Burial record for William Entwistle at St Peters church Bolton le Moors on 20 Apr 1767

### **William Entwistle's birth 1704**

William Entwistle had married Sarah Knowles in February 1734/5 and their children were born between 1738 and 1756 (see previous page). I searched on *Lancashire Online Parish Clerks* for a baptism record for a William Entwistle near Edgworth between and 1700 and 1720. There were 11 matches and several of these lived in or near Edgworth:

1. 20 Nov 1701 to Richard of Edgworth;
2. 14 Dec 1701 to Richard of Edgworth (probably the same child as number 1);
3. 2 Jul 1704 to William and Catherine of Quarlton (about 1 mile from Edgworth);
4. 17 Sep 1704 to Ralph and Hannah of Harwood (4.3 miles); probably died 5 April 1711
5. 17 Aug 1707 to John and Elizabeth of Haulgh (6.2 miles);
6. 20 Jan 1708 to Thomas of Upper Darwen (5.2 miles); probably died 29 Jan 1708
7. 6 Oct 1709 to William and Katherine of Harwood (4.3 miles);
8. 23 Aug 1710 to John and Jane of Turton (4.1 miles);
9. 25 Aug 1710 (no parents named), baptised at Tottington (3.5 miles);
10. 22 Jul 1711 to William of Upper Darwen (5.2 miles); and
11. 28 Nov 1711 to Ralph of Pollits (Rochdale) (13 miles).



William's known children were named Alice, William, Henry, Edmund and Joseph. None of the possible baptism records features a father named Henry, Edmund or Joseph. Subsequent generations of our branch of the Entwistle family did not use the names Richard, Ralph or Thomas. None of the female names from the list above feature in subsequent generations of our branch of the Entwistle family either. So, based on unfamiliar family names, I tentatively ruled out baptisms numbered 1 & 2 (Richard); 4 & 11 (Ralph and Hannah); and 6 (Thomas). That leaves 3, 5, 7, 8, 9 and 10.

The name John did get used (in 1784, 1788 and 1799) but William and Sarah (who had four sons) did not use it; so I tentatively ruled out baptisms numbered 5 and 8. So, based on family names, baptisms numbered 3, 7, 9 and 10 are more likely than the others.

Number 3 is the most likely of this group because the family lived much closer to Edgworth than the others (Tottington, Harwood and Upper Darwen). It is true that his mother's name (Catherine) does not feature in subsequent generations of our Entwistle family, but that could be due to the fact that William and Sarah only had one daughter (whose name – Alice - may have come her mother's family, the Knowles).

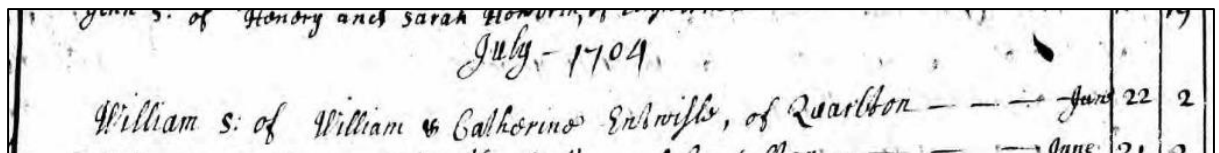


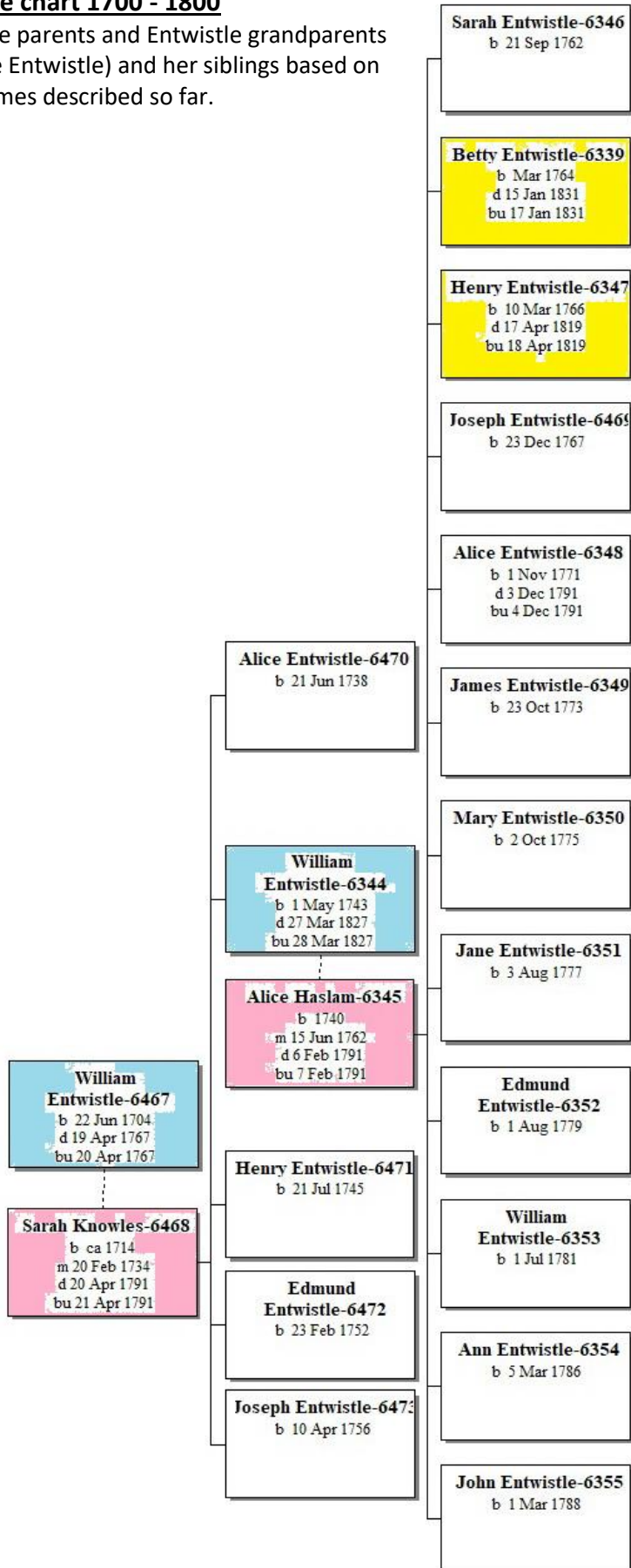
Illustration 11: Probable baptism record for William Entwistle at St Peter's Church, Bolton le Moors on 2 Jul 1704<sup>16</sup>

### Sarah Knowles birth

I searched *Lancashire Online Parish Clerks* for the birth of Sarah Knowles between 1700 and 1720. There were three matches, all from St Chad's church Rochdale, 12 miles from Edgworth. Only the father's names are given. There is insufficient evidence to choose any one of these over the others.

This chart shows the parents and Entwistle grandparents of Betty Grime (nee Entwistle) and her siblings based on the research outcomes described so far.



## Betty's Entwistle great-grandparents

Working on the hypothesis that 1704 William Entwistle of Quarlton is Betty's grandfather, I moved onto a search for details of his parents, William and Catherine.

### Siblings of 1704 William Entwistle

William's parents (William and Catherine) had five children between 1700 and 1718<sup>8</sup>, as follows:

1. 1 Jul 1700 Elin (Edgworth)
2. 2 Jul 1704 William (Quarlton)
3. 8 Jan 1713/4 Richard (Edgworth)
4. 11 Aug 1717 Ann (Turton)
5. 25 Dec 1718 Jane (Edgworth)

### Marriage of William Entwistle and Katherin Entwistle 1699

I searched for the marriage record for William and Catherine between 1695 and 1705. There was only one match. William Entwistle married Katherin Entwistle at St Peter's Church Bolton le Moors on 23 August 1699<sup>17</sup>; both were from Quarlton (where their son William was born 5 years later). It is likely that Katherine was a distant cousin of her new husband.

### William Entwistle's birth 1670

I next searched for a baptism record for William Entwistle between 1664 and 1684. There were four matches<sup>8</sup> but the parents of one of these lived at Quarlton (where William lived when he was married 24 years later). His parents were William and Ellin.

### Katherin Entwistle's birth 1677

A similar search between 1665 and 1685 for the baptism of Katherin Entwistle finds just one match. She was a daughter of Richard Entwistle of Edgworth<sup>19</sup>.

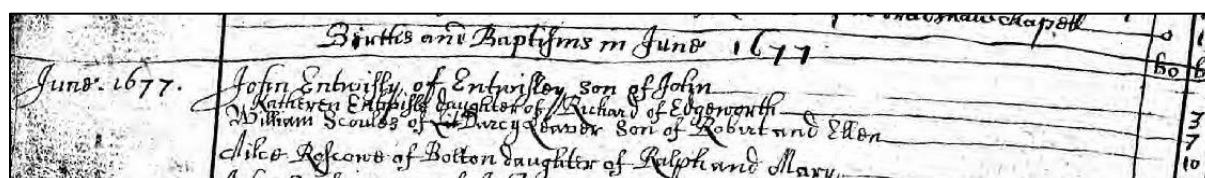


Illustration 14: Baptism record for Katheren Entwistle at St Peters Church Bolton le Moors on 7 Jun 1677

### Burial records for William and Katheren Entwistle

A search of *Lancashire Online Parish Clerks* for William Entwistle burial records between 1718 (when his youngest child was born) and 1728 has 9 matches. One of these lived at Edgeworth and was buried at St Anne's Church Turton on 1 December 1723. But it is more likely that the burial on 10 April 1719 at St Peter's Church Bolton le Moors<sup>20</sup> is our William because he lived at Quarlton and he died just five months after his youngest child was born. That would explain why there were no further children.

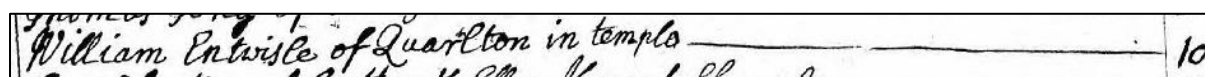


Illustration 15: Burial record for William Entwistle of Quarlton at St Peter's Church Bolton le Moors on 10 April 1719

His burial record indicates that he was buried "in templo", meaning inside the church. This was an exceedingly rare privilege reserved for highly respected citizens.

The most likely record for Katheren's burial was not until nearly 30 years later, on 16 December 1758 in the same church<sup>21</sup>. If this is her, she had moved to Entwistle (about 2 miles away).

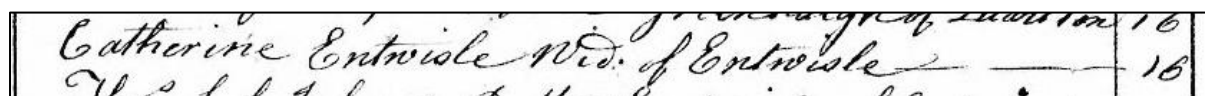


Illustration 16: Burial record for Catherine Entwistle of Entwistle at St Peter's Church Bolton le Moors on 16 Dec 1758

## Betty's Entwistle GG-grandparents

I had now established that Betty Entwistle's great grandparents may have been William and Catherine Entwistle of Quarlton. William's parents were William and Ellin. Before looking for their marriage records, I sought out the baptism records for their children.

### Siblings of 1670 William Entwistle

William and Ellin had three children<sup>8</sup> born at Quarlton, all baptised at St Peter's Church Bolton le Moors as follows:

1. 30 Apr 1666 Thomas
2. 27 Oct 1667 Ellin
3. 7 Nov 1670 William

### Marriage of William Entwistle and Ellin Greenhalgh

There is only one possible marriage record for William and Ellin. They were married in St Peter's Church Bolton le Moors on 30 May 1665<sup>22</sup>. Her maiden name was Greenhalgh.

The record reads:

*William Entwistle of Edgeworth } now legally published in Boulton church, (w)ithout contravention &  
Ellin Greenehaulgh of Quarleton } now married at Boulton church by M Robert Harpur vicar thew may*

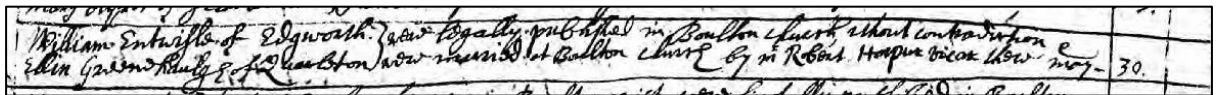


Illustration 17: Marriage record of William Entwistle and Ellin “Greenehalgh” at St Peters Church Bolton le Moors on 30 May 1665

### Burial records for William and Ellin Entwistle

A search of Lancashire Online Parish Clerks between 1670 (when her youngest child was born) and 1690 located the burial record for Ellin Entwistle nee Greenhalgh on 2 August 1678<sup>23</sup>. The note “wife of William” indicates that he survived her.

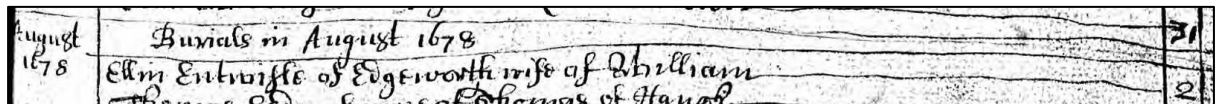


Illustration 18: Burial record for Ellin Entwistle at St Peters Church Bolton le Moors on 2 Aug 1678

A search of Lancashire Online Parish Clerks for William Entwistle burials between 1678 and 1808 locates 12 matches, of which three lived at Edgworth. The first of these is the most likely record for this William Entwistle – on 8 Apr 1701<sup>24</sup>. He was, like his son 18 years later, buried within the church (*intra Ecclo.*). This was a rare privilege and may indicate that he was a church warden or vestryman.

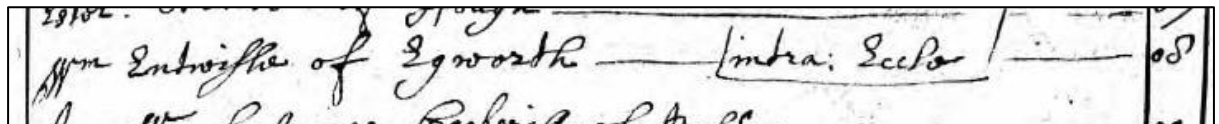


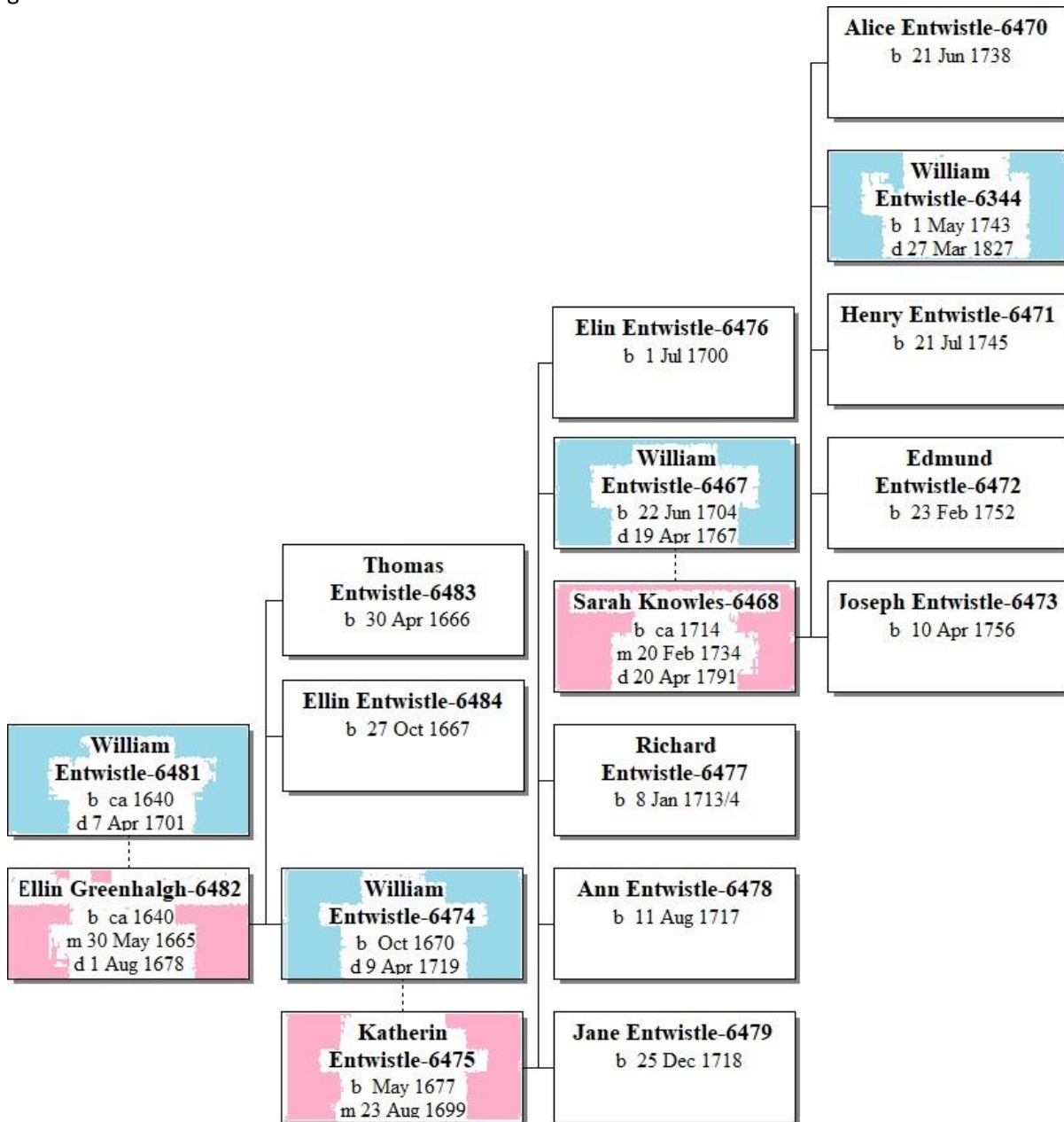
Illustration 19: Burial record for William Entwistle at St Peter’s Church Bolton le Moors on 8 April 1701

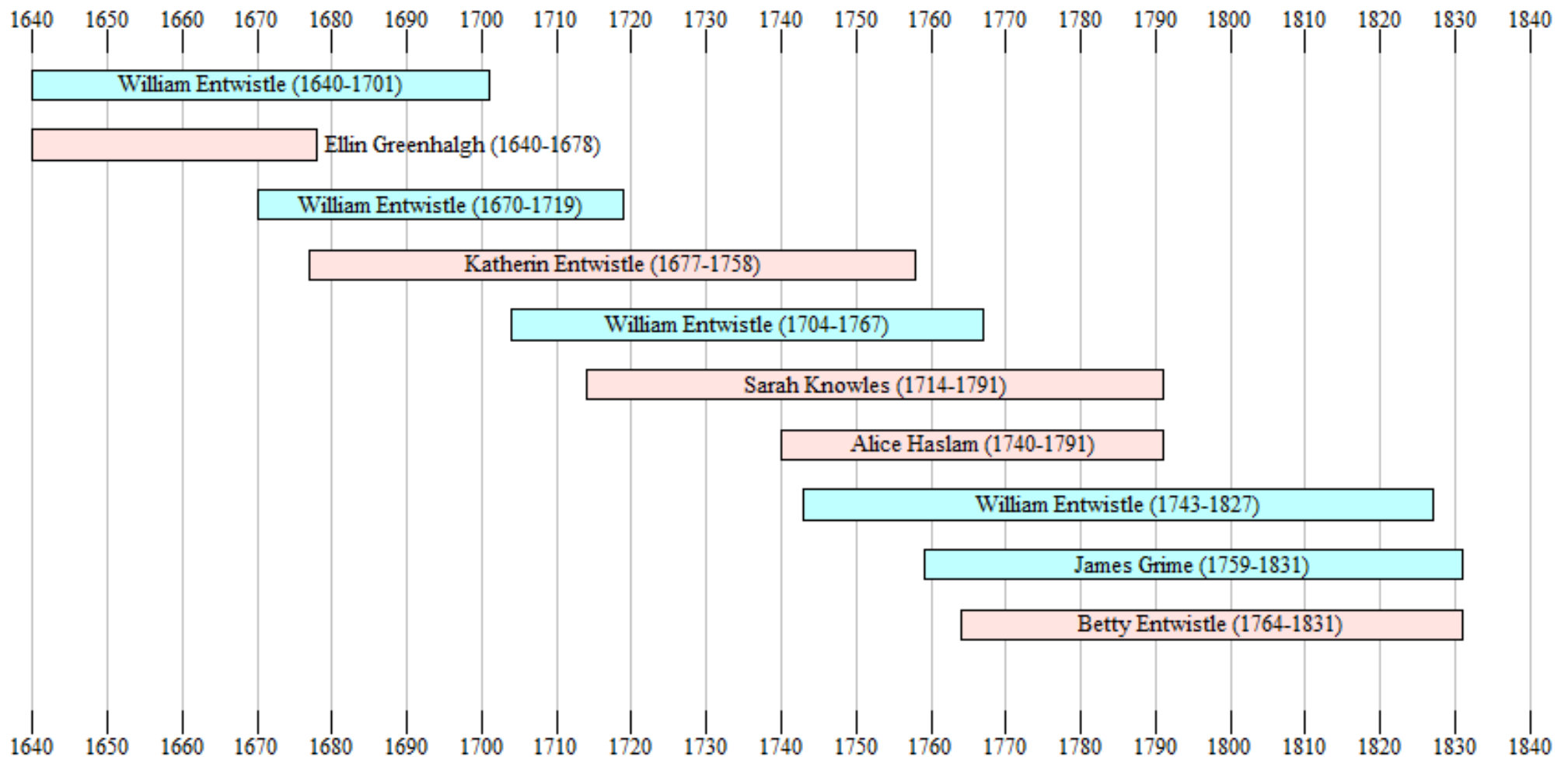
There are several baptism records that could relate to Ellin Greenhalgh; and there are several that could relate to this William Entwistle. So, we have gone as far back as we can without further information.

This chart shows the Entwistle grandparents of Betty Grime (William Entwistle and Sarah Knowles) and two previous generations – based on the research outcomes described above

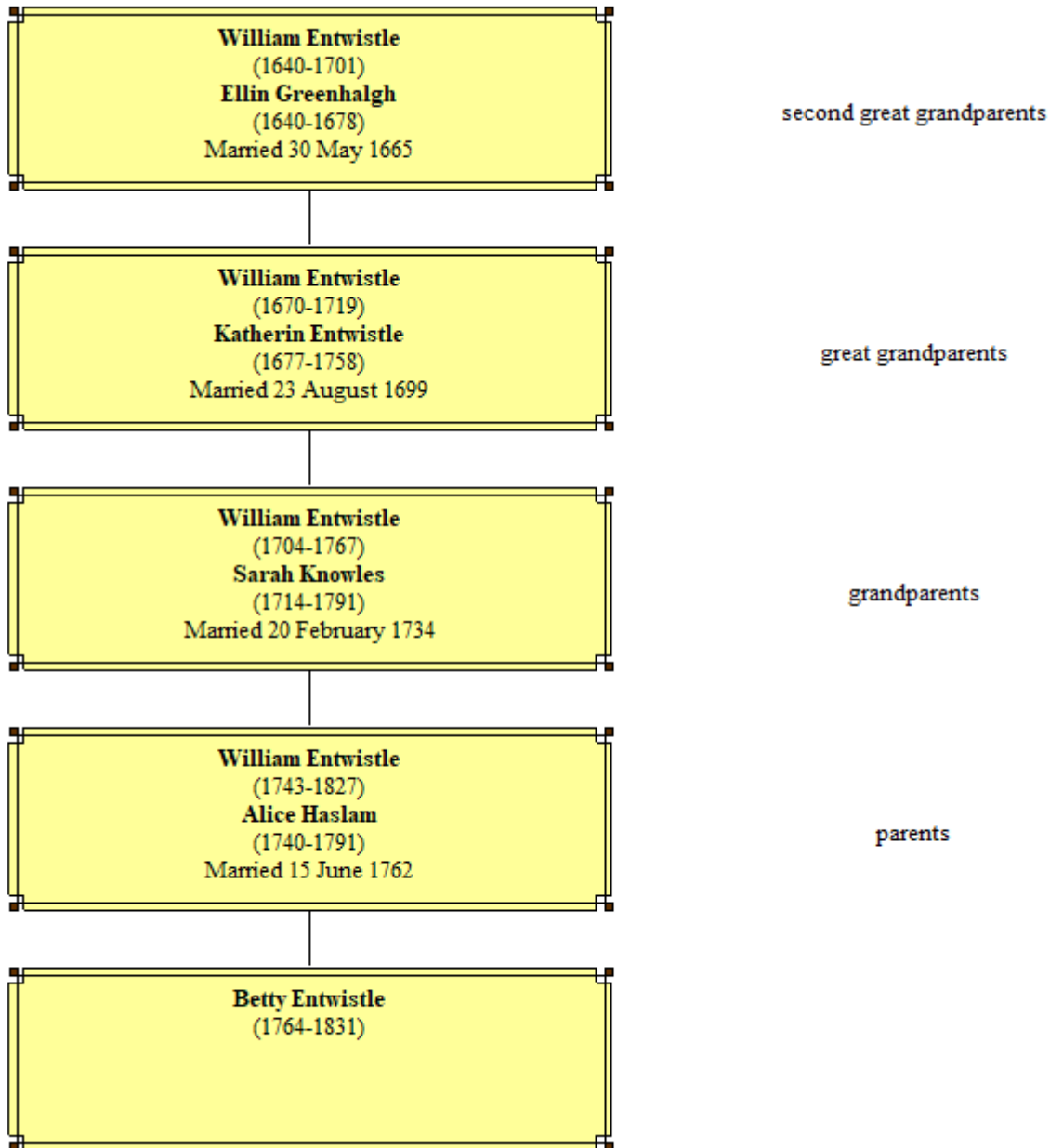


**Entwistle family timeline 1640 – 1840**
