## **1801 CENSUS OF EDGWORTH**

A list from an article in the Bolton Chronicle on 24<sup>th</sup> November 1906.

158 inhabited houses occupied by the same number of families, but these also included boarders and lodgers: the grand total enumerated being 1,003. 501 were males and 502 females. Of persons occupied in agriculture there were only 8; in trade manufactures or handicrafts 719, while those not comprised in the two preceding classes numbered 277.
