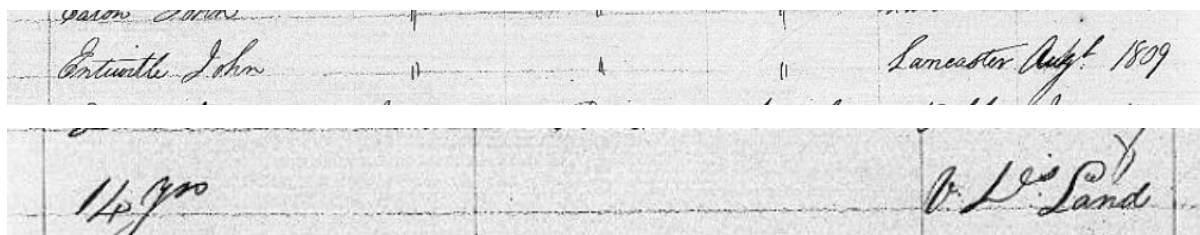

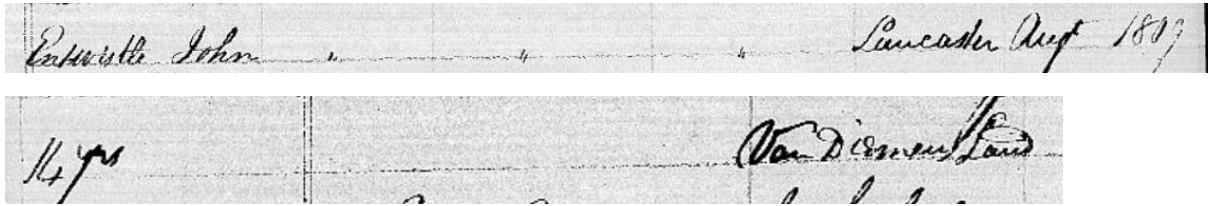
The government then chartered *Ruby* to carry a detachment of the [73rd Regiment of Foot](#) under the command of Major Andrew Geils, who had been appointed Commandant at Hobart. She also transported 80 convicts from Port Jackson to [Van Diemen's Land](#). Troops and convicts embarked on *Ruby* on 10 February 1812.^[16]

Ruby left Van Diemen's Land on 26 March 1812, and returned to Bengal.^[17]

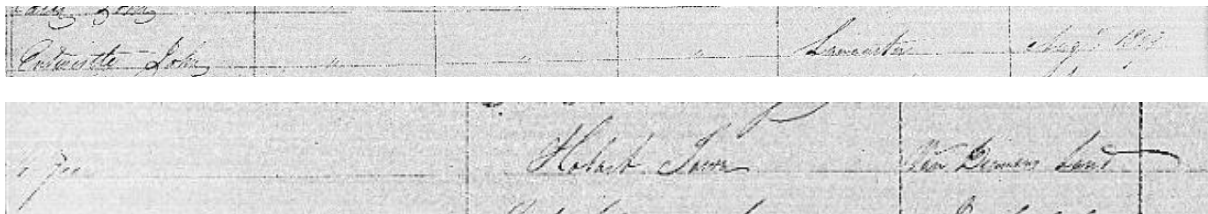

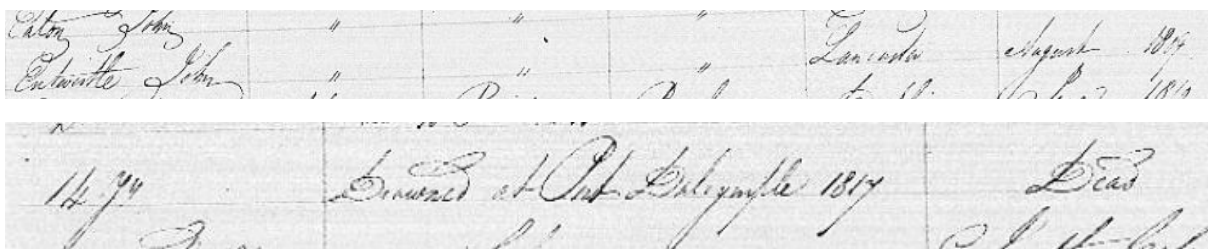
