On Friday the 16th. Inst. An Inquest was held on the body of John Entwistle, who was unfortunately drowned in conveying a Cow and calf from Kangaroo Bay to Hobart-town, the following are the particulars of the melancholy Accident. Joseph Hearty, W. Taylor, R. Gilbert, John George, T. Heath, and John Entwistle, after having got the cow and calf into the boat, the cow became so refractory as to knock a hole in the bottom, by which the whole of the before mentioned persons were precipitated into the water. J. Hearty, W. Taylor, and R. Gilbert preserved themselves by clinging to the boat, the rest were unfortunately drowned. The Jury returned a Verdict—Drowned by Accident.
