On Wednesday arrived the Covernment Messenger from Port Dalrymple, bringing the uni leating intelligence of William Ent. wiftle to young man univertally known to most of our Reade-s here) having been drowned on Friday morning the 24th inftant, at the New River, opposite the farm of Mr. T. M. ffey, vort Dalrymple. The Government Mellerger left town acc masnied with Entwiftle, and fwam the river on his mare with the grea eft difficulty, owing to the rapidity of the current, which was occasioned by an unexpected fall of rain from the adjecent me untains. fortunate man followed on an entire hoife, who when in the current plunged to fuch a degree that Entwittle was thrown, and never fince heard of .- This accident is peculiarly melancholy, owing to the univerfal respect and esteem in which the syoung man was held by the inhabitants of this Settlement. We have to acd, that the Core oner of the county (I. ARCHER, Efq) gave every surettion respecting the recevery of the body, which when the messenger left the Settlement was unavailable.
