REGISTRATION OF BRANDS ACT OF 1866.

SECOND LIST OF CATTLE BRANDS—FIRST NOTIFICATION.


NOTICE is hereby given, in terms of the provisions of section 8 of the above-named Act, that the persons whose names and addresses are entered in the appended List have made due application to register the Cattle Brands therein set opposite their respective names; and that if, within two months from the date of this notification, no objection be made by any other person, on account of his owning a Cattle Brand similar to any of those hereby notified, such Brand shall be deemed to belong to the persons so applying for the registration thereof, and shall be registered accordingly.

The attention of stock-owners and the public is called to this Notice and the appended List of Brands; and applicants whose names appear therein, are requested to see that their brands and names, and the postal addresses of the places or stations where the brands applied for are intended to be used, are correctly given, in order that all notices may be addressed to the proper post towns of such places or stations.

2. If any error or omission be observed, the applicant should at once communicate the fact to this department; and in doing so, he should be careful to give the brand and number set opposite to his name, as well as his address.
